Starting at the Black Rock Community Council Building on Arthur Street, the parade route will hug the shoreline abutting Long Island Sound and Ash Creek, ending at Port 5 in time to kick off the afternoon's Harborfest activities.

This event is open to all kids, and those young at heart, that wish to decorate their bike or golf cart to reflect Black Rock's 375-year history and celebrate the spirit of our vibrant neighborhood and community. Prizes will be awarded for the best costume and for the most spirited vehicle (cart or bicycle) entered in the parade.

All children on bicycles must wear bike helmets and closed shoes. Scooters and skateboards are not permitted. Small children must be accompanied by an adult. Golf cart operators must carry a valid Connecticut driver's license.
